Braibant Lecture

The Braibant lecture is an award granted by the Institute to an individual, for his/her contribution to the advancement of the public governance discipline. It is named after Guy Braibant, Président de la section du rapport et des études du Conseil d'Etat (1985-1992) and IIAS Director General (1979-1981) and President (1992-1995).

IIAS Scientific Committee has awarded Prof. Dr. Elio Borgonovi as Braibant lecturer 2022. Elio Borgonovi is emeritus Professor in Public Management and Policy of SDA Bocconi, founder of the Centre for Research on Health and Social Care Management (CERGAS), author of numerous publications, instrumental in the development of the academic field of public administration in Italy.

The evolution from bureaucratic to governance model of public administration is currently at a turning point. Actually, the environment is characterized by some megatrends as dramatic development of science and technology innovation, global warming, green transition and digital transformation. The consequence is that the present and the future society is and will be more and more characterized by velocity, volatility, variability, volume and new vulnerabilities. In this complexity environment the professionality of public managers is no longer "the right way to achieve objectives defined by politics and law" but should and must become the right way to contribute to pursue the right objectives, that means to the purpose driven.
